Our Finance Committee is charged with oversight of the operating budget of the church, along with the monitoring of financial accounts. The Committee, which prepares the annual budget, meets quarterly or more frequently if needed. It consists of committee chairs of the standing committees of the church, as well as atlarge members and the pastoral team.

The Finance Committee reviews the monthly financial reports on at least a quarterly basis (all committee members receive reports monthly for their review), review credit card purchases on the church's credit cards along with reviewing the

investment portfolio and bank accounts of the church. At least quarterly, the Committee meets with the Investment manager of the William Drendall Endowment (SevenBridge Financial Group, LLC) and reviews performance, asset allocation and current market conditions.

In addition, the Finance Committee works with and provides financial support to other committees on various church projects. A good example is the church's elevator project, which was undertaken in 2023. Members of the Finance Committee collaborated with members of the MGUMC Trustees by keeping track of the funds coming into the project and the disbursements going out.

The Church's monthly financial reports are prepared by members of the Committee (Treasurer and Financial Secretary) and reviewed by the Finance Committee, as well as MGUMC's Administrative Council.

On an annual basis, there is an audit of various financial practices and procedures of the church. This is not an audit by the Finance Committee, but by a team of auditors (members of the church). This team reports any recommendations and/or findings to the Finance Committee, which then reports to the Administrative Council.
