# **Solar Panel Update**

**Contracts have been signed** for the installation of solar panels on the sanctuary roof. We anticipate installation will occur in late May. This project was made possible by the generous gift of \$50,000 from the estate of the father of one of our members who has chosen to remain anonymous.

Because donations like this are the responsibility of Trustees, they established an Ad Hoc Committee to discern how best to allocate these funds. That committee voted in December to proceed with the solar project, and MGUMC Administrative Council approved the recommendation at its Jan. 15 meeting.
